

MULTIMODAL AWARDS

Terms and Conditions of Entry

The Multimodal Team administer the 2024 Multimodal Awards (the “Awards”).

1. Nominations and eligibility

1.1. The Multimodal Awards are free to enter and anyone may be nominated to receive a Modal Award, provided they are a company or person operating in the transport, logistics and supply chain management industry.

1.2. Nominations must be submitted online via the Multimodal Awards website. Multimodal reserves the right to refuse any entries that are incomplete or not in the correct format.

1.3. By submitting the nomination form, the entrant:

1.3.1. Will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions;

1.3.2. Confirms that they are authorised to do so by the Company, if they are acting on behalf of the Company, for example a PR or marketing agency; and;

1.3.3. Confirms that the nominee is eligible to be nominated to receive an Award in the relevant Award category.

1.4. Nominations for the Modal Awards must be submitted and received by midnight on 29 March 2024. Multimodal accepts no responsibility for entries that are incomplete, lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

1.5. Multimodal reserves the right to extend the closing date for nomination submissions.

2. Publicity

2.1. Multimodal does not claim any rights of ownership over the contents of any entry.

2.2. By submitting an entry and any accompanying material, you agree that:

2.2.1. Multimodal may, but is not required to, use:

2.2.1.1. the content of the entry;

2.2.1.2. the business name;

2.2.1.3. descriptions of the projects within the Award submissions; and

2.2.1.4. nominations and winning entries, including their name and logo, images and video content

2.3. For publicity purposes, including but not limited to future marketing material and promotion of the Awards, the Multimodal website, in communications, in media promotions, at the Awards ceremony, in marketing collateral (including adverts), in publications and social media, unless the entrant withholds such consent to this in writing.

2.4. The content of the entry must be lawful and not confidential;

2.5. Multimodal will collect, retain, use and distribute your personal data in order to help Multimodal process and manage the Awards entry. Will be processed in accordance with

2.6. If the entry contains any personal details relating to another individual, you have the permission of that individual to share their personal data with Multimodal for the purposes described in these terms and conditions

2.7. 3. Judging Entries for the written Awards must be submitted by midnight on 1st May 2024, unless previously agreed in writing with the Multimodal Team. Written entries are sent to an independent panel of judges for the judging process. Should a large amount of entries be received these will be filtered down by a pre-judging committee and the finalists entries sent through to the judging panel.

3.1. CLIENT PERMISSION: It is a condition of entry that the company must obtain approval from the client: (i) to nominate a project for an Award; (ii) to submit details and photos of the project (for the purposes set out in these terms and conditions); and (iii) to provide the client's personal contact details to Multimodal (for the purposes of verifying the entry). Entrants will be required to confirm they, or their nominee, have received such client consent when submitting a nomination and will be responsible for any liability incurred by Multimodal as a result of or in connection with such consent not having been obtained.

3.2. In each stage the judges will (acting reasonably) determine the standard of each Award category and may not give an Award in any category if, in their view, entries are not of sufficient merit.

3.3. The judges' decisions are final and Awards will be assigned at their discretion. No correspondence will be entered in to.

3.4. Please also note that due to the high volume of entries received it is not possible to provide individual feedback for entries.

3.5. The winners of each category will be announced at the Multimodal Awards ceremony on 11th June 2024.

4. Voting

By participating in the Multimodal Modal Awards Vote you agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions:

4.1. It is a condition of your use of this voting facility that you do not do any of the following: (a) Impersonate any person, company, association, organisation, government, body or entity; (b) Attempt to "stack" votes by voting more frequently than intended or encourage others to engage in any form of vote stacking.

4.2. The Vote is not open to shortlisted companies, employees of shortlisted companies, their subsidiaries, families, agents, affiliates, or anyone involved in running the competition.

4.3. Multimodal Awards 2024 reserves the right to cancel or suspend voting at any time.

4.4. The eligibility of any vote is at the sole discretion of Multimodal Awards 2024.

4.5. Multimodal Awards 2024 reserves the right to disqualify votes if it has reasonable grounds to suspect that fraudulent voting has occurred or if it considers there has been any attempt to rig the voting.

4.6. Multimodal Awards 2024, its sub-contractors, subsidiaries and/or agencies cannot accept any responsibility whatsoever for any technical failure or malfunction or any other problem with the internet connectivity or line, system, server, provider or otherwise which may result in any vote being lost or not properly registered or recorded.

4.7. Multimodal Awards' 2024 decision in relation to all matters affecting the vote is final.
